STEP 1



Go to GRF Pledging Website

STEP 2

STEP 3



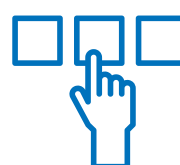
Select Multi-stakeholder Pledge

You are asked if your pledge is in support of a multi-stakeholder pledge. Select "yes".

STEP 4

Choose Pledge

Select "Achieving 15% Enrolment by 2030 to Expanding Refugee Access to Higher Education". To select/link to multiple pledges, hold ctrl (Windows)/cmd (Mac). Click "Next Page".



STEP 5



Enter Pledge Information

Insert the pledge details. To select multiple items, hold ctrl (Windows)/cmd (Mac). Here you can also match pledges. Please include 15by30/higher education in the pledge description. Click "Next: final step to review".

STEP 6

Confirm and Submit

You **must** click the Confirm button at the bottom of the final review page to finalise your response. You can print or save the page for your records in the end.
